Issues:

1. Salary Schedule 2011-2012

Management reiterated that the Boards position is a 2.75% salary reduction. The question was asked to us about what we thought of the cut of 2.75% and how we want to do the cuts.

Teachers have worked for years for experience to be bumped at a particular step. MEA's position is that step will be given for this year.

- 6. Life insurance...what is the rate and is it guaranteed? Forrest will get the rates and present them in the future to us.
- 7. Tobacco-free campus No one should be smoking where students can see them. Management is interested in posting a tobacco free sign for all property owned by the school district.

8. Management is interested in transitioning to 6 out of 7 periods per day district wide and not school by school.
